Vancouver Olympic Club Family Volunteer Policy, 2012

Our parent and family volunteer policy is vital to the effective running of our Club and its activities. It is required that each family completes the minimum requirements. Each family must write one post-dated cheque in the amount of **\$200 dated November 30, 2012**. The cheque will be held in trust and will be cashed only if you fail to complete your volunteer hours. All families meeting their required number of volunteer hours will be able to retrieve their post-dated cheque at the end of the season.

Parent and family members will be required to complete a minimum of **10 hours** of volunteer service per family by the end of the season that should include 4 hours of volunteer service at the Annual Track Meet hosted by VOC. **Hosting the VOC annual meet is a total membership effort!**

Attached is a **Volunteer Hours Record Sheet**. It is the responsibility of each family to record its volunteer hours on an honour basis as they are completed. Do not lose your record sheet. There will NOT be any other way of confirming your hours. If you require additional blank forms, you can obtain one from our VOC web site.

If the conditions of the volunteer policy that apply to your family are not fulfilled, the Club will cash your cheque. The objective of the Club's Volunteer Policy is not to earn extra cash for the Club. It is to ensure adult participation. Training and experience will enrich everyone's enjoyment of our sport. All our members, coaches and parents will benefit from your energetic participation in the Club's activities.

In order to allow our coaches to maximize coaching time and to focus on our children's development it is vital that at **every practice** we have parent volunteers to:

- Set up and take down equipment at each practice
- Assist the coaches by recording technical stats for each athlete

- A lead co-ordinator to ensure the right children get to the right events at the right time
- A results checker
- General helpers
- Organise accommodation for out of town meets
